

## **CAMP TRINITY HURRICANE EVACUATION POLICY**

In case of hurricane watch and warnings for Camp Trinity on Bogue Island, the following evacuation procedures will be put into effect:

- Condition 4**            Transportation availability will be confirmed.
- Condition 3**            Watch: 36-48 hours to forecasted landfall. Liaison with the Rector of St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Kinston, will be established.
- Condition 2**            Warning: 24-35 hours to forecasted landfall. Prepare camp, Camp Staff, and campers for evacuation.
- Condition 1**            Evacuation: 18-24 hours to forecasted landfall. Board buses and travel best route to St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Kinston, NC.

Because high profile vehicles are not permitted on the bridges after wind speeds exceed 45 mph, evacuation may begin during Condition 2. An assessment will be made, utilizing strike probability information, time of day of expected Condition 1 call, and other pertinent data to establish a conservative evacuation time.

Parents, please do not call the Camp Trinity office or Trinity Center during this time. The Trinity Center staff will call parents if evacuation occurs.

If campers are evacuated and return to camp is not feasible because of damage or end of session, campers must be picked up in Kinston.
