Dr. Roberts is Professor of Church Music at Virginia Theological Seminary (Episcopal). Previously he was Director of Music at St. John's, Lafayette Square, Washington, D.C. He has held similar positions in Tucson, Newport Beach, Louisville, and Houston. He has taught at Indiana University Southeast, Mars Hill College, Louisville Presbyterian Seminary and Southern Seminary.

As organist, choirmaster and composer he has widely published choral works for children's and adult choirs as well as articles in several Anglican journals. He chaired the Episcopal Church's Standing Commission on Church Music and the Leadership Program for Musicians, as well as serving on the AAM Seminary Music Initiative and the mentoring Task Force. He is the author of the recent book *Music and Vital Congregations*, published by Church Publishing INC, New York and available as an e-book on GoogleBooks and Kindle. Dr. Roberts' expertise in working with our youth is invaluable and the youth have a tremendous amount of fun.

This camp is designed for rising 4<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> graders. The choristers will stay in dorms and need to bring linens, swimsuits, towels, snacks, and if they wish, musical instruments.

Youth Camp Supervisors are present at all times and at least two adult advisors will be housed in each dorm. Free time will be supervised for safety reasons. Please remember to complete and sign the Medical Release Form and return it with your registration. Counselors in Training must be in, at least, the 11<sup>th</sup> grade and pay the full registration fee. Four CITs will be chosen, two of whom must be male.
